Jay Reynolds was raised in Artesia, N.M. where upon high school graduation he attended Texas Tech University and obtained a Bachelor of Arts in Business Finance in 1978. This degree was followed by attending Southern Methodist University where he graduated in 1979 with a Master in Business Administration. Following graduation he worked for ARCO Oil and Gas in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
