

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Midland County Hospital District conducted public hearings on August 10, 2011 and August 24, 2011 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Midland County Hospital District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 1.41 percent.

The total tax revenue raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.16633 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$20,592,536.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.16220 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$20,882,687.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.16220 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$21,196,880.

The Board of Directors of Midland County Hospital District is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on August 31, 2011 at the Midland Memorial Hospital Board Room, 2200 Illinois, Midland, Texas at 1:10 p.m.
